

Traffic Safety Advisory

We sincerely request that parents consider the following:

It is illegal to:

- Park on any marked crosswalk or within 6 m of the approach side of a crosswalk. If you do, you are in contravention of Traffic Bylaw 98-186. Parking on the crosswalk forces young children to attempt to cross the road elsewhere and puts them at risk to be hit by a vehicle. Obey driving laws and regulations.
- Make a U-turn if it interferes with other traffic
- Park across the entrance to a driveway or intersection
- Park where a curb is painted yellow



Other reminders:

- The <u>lane/driveway in front of the school is closed</u> to all traffic except staff, fire, and vehicles equipped with a handicap pass.
- Use the 'Kiss & Go' lane. Follow the yellow arrows and drop-off in the upper level at the end of the drive-through. Do not stop at the start or middle.
- Safely walking, cycling, riding scooters and skateboards require continuous reinforcement both at home and at school. This equipment are not to be used on school property until after 2:45 pm.
- A reminder to parents that there are lots of students out and about during peak drop off and pick up times and we urge you to use extra caution while driving.
- Also, parents are asked to use the sidewalks if walking their children to and from school and not to cut through the parking lot as it is not safe.
