Kiss and Go Lane Procedures

Use the 'Kiss & Go' lane to drop off students between the hours of 8:00 and 2:00 pm. Please note, supervision is only provided between 8:00 and 8:25 before school. It is now only one lane and as always, there is no parking.

We have added a pedestrian only area in the lane so that parents do not have to wait to be at the top of the lane – once they are stopped anywhere in the lane, their child can safely exit the vehicle and make their way to our stairs and then onto the school. Students and visitors to the school should stay on the marked crosswalks and not cut through the parking lot to enter the school.



Under no circumstances are vehicles allowed to be parked anywhere in the *Kiss and Go Lane*.

Parents of younger students in Kindergarten and Grade one who wish to physically drop off and pick-up their children at their classrooms are encouraged to find a regular spot on the street to park. Once parked, parents/guardians can then accompany their child to the playground or classroom drop off location. This procedure can also be followed at the end of the day for pick-up.
