

Responsible Use of Technology Devices in Schools

A reminder to staff, students, and families that the use of personal technology devices during the school day in elementary schools is restricted.

These devices (any device used to communicate and/or access the internet) include mobile phones, Apple watches, Smart watches, laptops, and iPads. These devices are to be turned off and stored during the day in a backpack or other teacher approved location. Furthermore, they are never to be used in spaces where privacy is expected, such as a washroom or change room. For more information, see page 7 [here](#).



- Students are permitted to use personal digital devices to support accessibility, accommodations, medical and health needs.
- Schools will ensure that all students have equitable and developmentally appropriate access to technology to meet curricular requirements.
- Staff may revoke a student's access to devices because of inappropriate student conduct. Violations of the school code of conduct could result in appropriate restorative processes or disciplinary actions including suspension and police intervention.
