Respect for Ourselves	- Always give your best effort - Dress appropriately - Ask for help if needed - Leave chewing gum at home - Make healthy and safe choices (no smoking, drugs or alcohol) - Be your own boss	- Walk calmly, safely quietly, and in a single file - Be on time - Stay on the right side	- Play in designated areas and be safe (do not play on northside of school) "Park" all bikes, scooters, skateboards - Follow rules of the game you're playing - Stay on school grounds - Pick up after yourself - One person at a time on swings, monkey bars, spinner and slides	- Use good manners; stay at your seat and use an indoor voice. - Stay in your classroom unless you have permission from a Supervisor - When finished eating, find a quiet activity (read, draw, color, board game, homework) - Eat healthy food (i.e. fruit & veggies)	- Wait for teacher or supervisor permission before entering - Use designated doors - Ask Supervisor for a pass to use the washroom - Be safe - Be helpful	- Sign out your books - Use computers appropriately - Use the Internet only when you have permission from a teacher - Avoid giving personal information when using the Internet	- Choose appropriate people to sit by - Settle quickly and sit in your own space - Sit on your bottom - Sit quietly & listen actively	- Flush the toilet - Use only enough toilet paper or paper towel as you need - Wash hands
Respect for Others	- Be kind and use manners - Share and include others - Listen actively - Keep your hands & feet to yourself - Respect others' thoughts & opinions	- Keep hands & feet to yourself - Use appropriate language & volume - Move forward and look forward - Leave displays and bulletin boards alone - Stay quiet in the hallway so you don't disturb others	- Include others in activities, games and be a good sport - Report unsafe activity - Use equipment properly & return it to where you got it - Leave others' creations alone - Sticks, sand, snow and stones stay on the ground - No piggybacking, lifting or backflips	- Practice good manners - Listen to and be respectful to classroom monitors - Use appropriate language & volume - Visit the washroom alone - Be aware of food allergies	- Be on time - Enter & exit quickly & quietly - Keep personal space - Stay in line - Hold the door for others - Meet your parents at the exit door - Stay back from the front of the entry doors	- Visit the library when it is open - Return books on time - Use a quiet voice and walking feet - Use your manners when signing out books or using the computers - Use headphones when using a program with sound - Log off when finished	- Clap politely at appropriate times - Look at the speaker or presentation - Keep your hands & feet to yourself - Stand to ask questions - Sing O Canada appropriately - When returning to class, avoid disturbing others	- Respect others' privacy - Enter & exit quickly & quietly - Leave lights on - Report silly or unsafe behavior - Flush the toilet - Use only enough toilet paper, water, soap, and paper as you need
Respect for the Environment	- Reduce, reuse & recycle - Throw garbage in cans - Write or print only on paper - Play in supervised areas only (i.e. the gym is not supervised at lunch so you cannot go in the gym at lunch) - Do not go behind storage bins - Stay off portable railings	- Pick up litter - Clean up after yourself - Keep lockers clean & organized - Report vandalism & unsafe behavior - Report spills	- Pick up litter - Clean up after yourself - Respect school property including blue bins, gardens, plants, trees & grounds - Do not play in garden boxes - One person at a time on swings and no twisting	- Clean up after yourself - Wipe off desk when finished eating - Sit on chairs only - Place garbage in can and take home any leftovers - Reduce, reuse & recycle	- Dress appropriately for the weather - Wipe your feet and brush off snow or debris before entering - Enter & exit through the proper doors	- Eat food & drinks elsewhere to avoid damaging the books or computers - Push in your chair when leaving - Use equipment appropriately	- Clean up after yourself - Leave area neat & tidy - Put away materials - Use inside, clean shoes	- Use only enough toilet paper, water, soap, and paper as you need - Keep water in the sink area - Use garbage, recycling and composting bins
